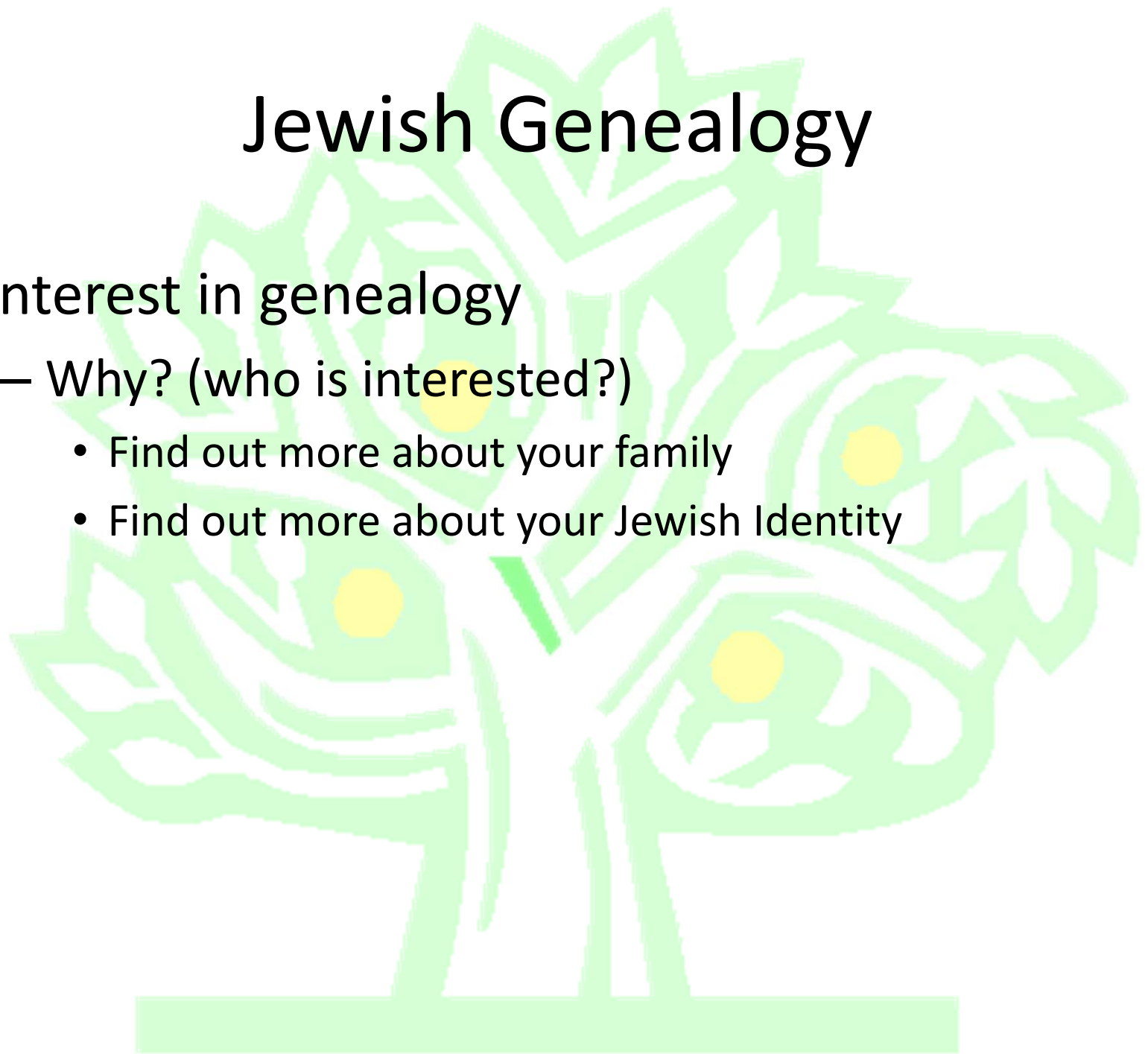
Jewish Genealogy

 - Shoah

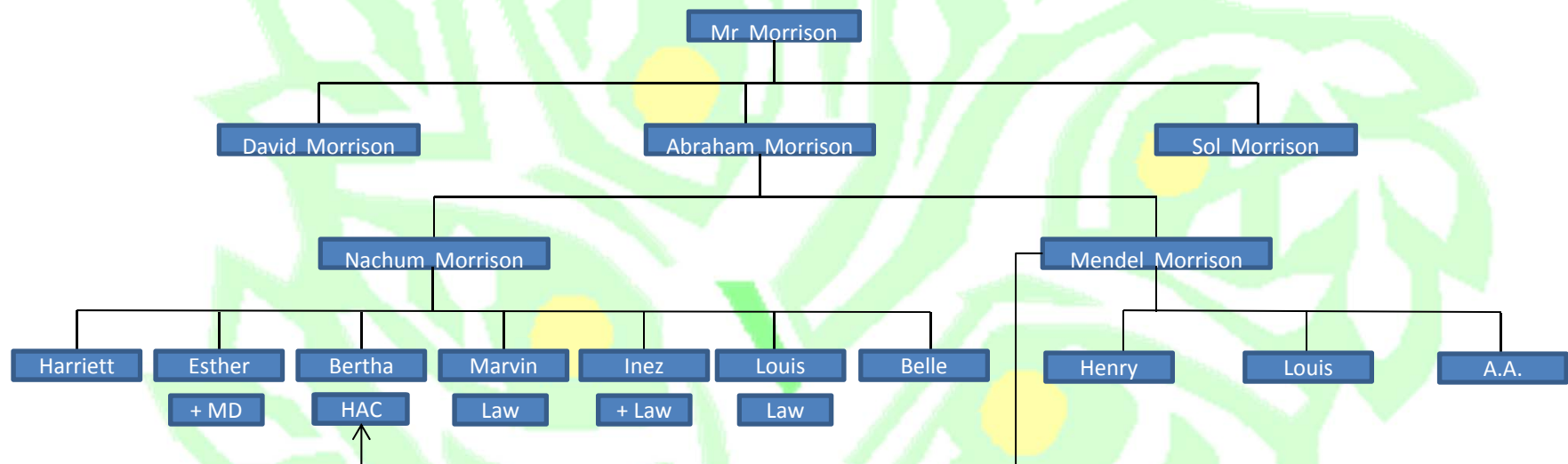

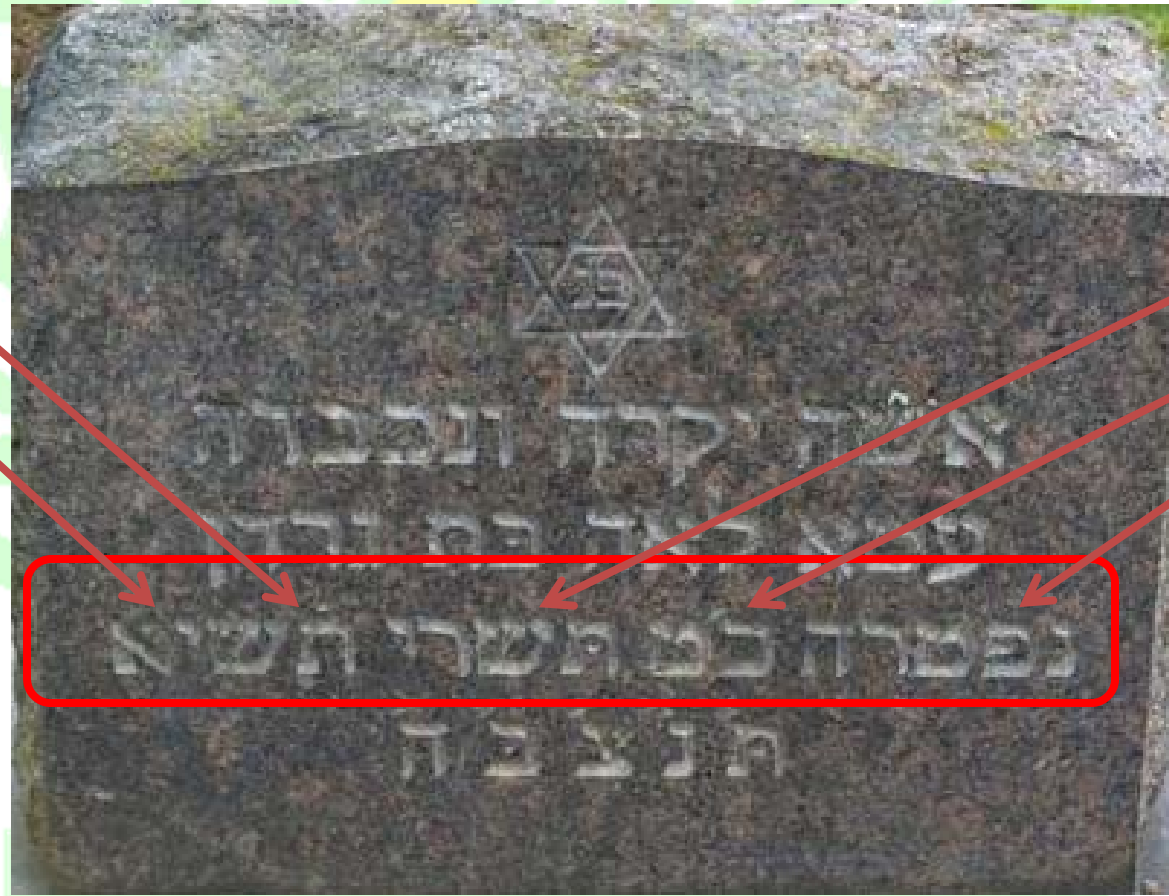
